Experiences of people with disabilities with cancer Some people had someone close who had cancer They talked about suffering, treatment, and a terrible experience Some people knew what the cause of the disease was Sometimes the family didn't talk to them about this disease. They didn't like it	
No experiences associated with cancer Some people didn't know anyone who had cancer Sometimes they confused cancer with other diseases, such as a heart attack.	
Cancer prevention Some people said that they take care of their health to avoid getting cancer They eat healthily They don't smoke cigarettes They regularly undergo preventive screenings Women go for cytology, breast ultrasound (USG), and mammograms Men undergo prostate ultrasound (USG) Other people don't undergo preventive screenings. They don't know what needs to be done to avoid getting sick.	
We need trainings so that people with disabilities knew how to prevent cancer We are planning to prepare three trainings: - about healthy food - about screening - about physical activity and sun protection
